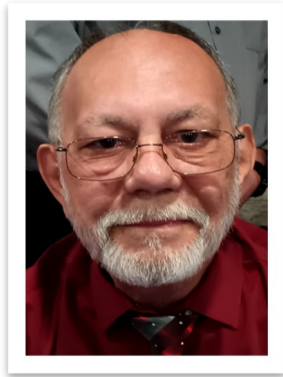

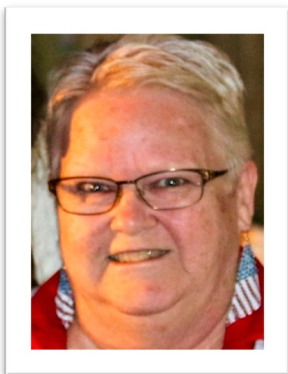

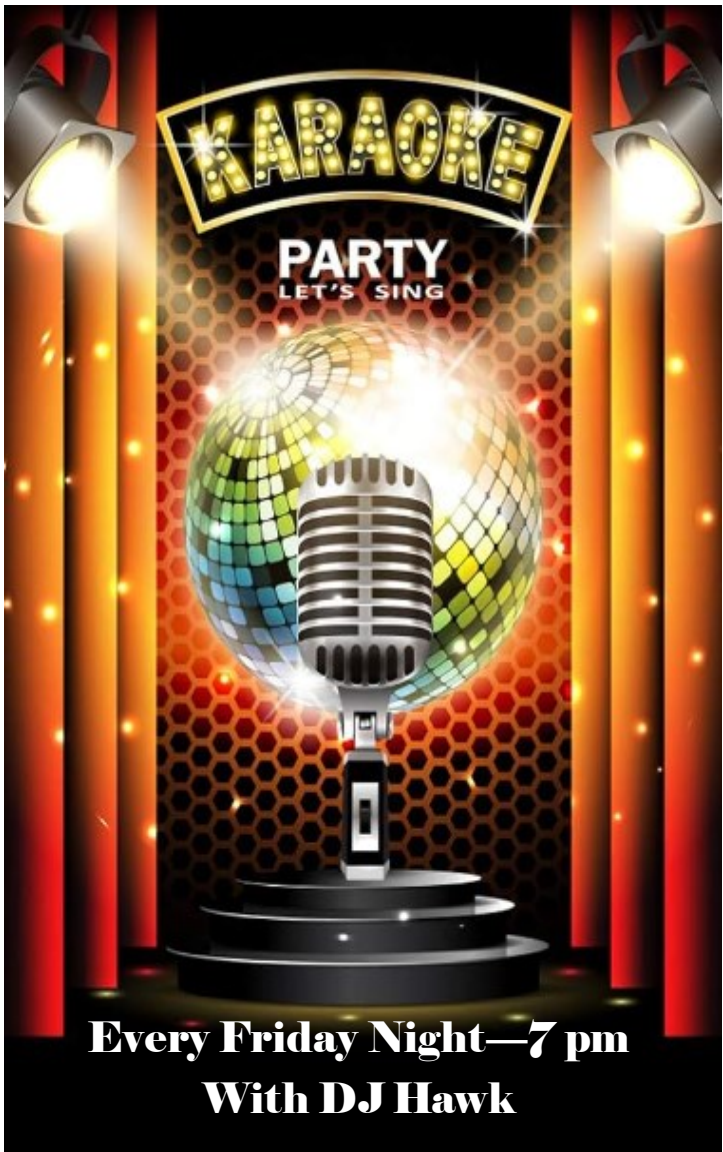

The Georgia State Convention is June 1st and June 2nd.



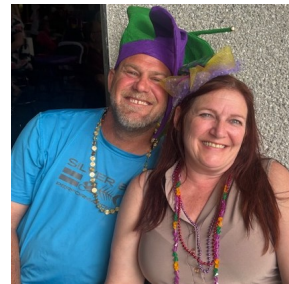
